ORDER

The institutions shall ensure the fulfillment of the following :-

- The institutions shall maintain the teaching staff strength of 1+5 for the sanctioned D.Ed. course and all the appointments would be on regular basis on an approved scale of payment of the candidates having fulfilled eligibility condition prescribed by NCTE. The institute concerned shall send a report in this regard to WRC of NCTE within 30 days, in terms of clause 7 (12) of the NCTE Regulation dt. 21.7.2006.
- The institutions shall not relax in regard to NET / SLET requirement, the relaxation is allowed only upto the year 2009-2010 as per NCTE Regulation dt. 21.7.2006.
- The institutions shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
- The institutions shall within one month of the receipt of the Recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of

- not less than 60 months (Five Years) in a Nationalized Bank only to be done with an authorized official of the Regional Committee.
- That the Reserve fund for an amount of Rs. Three Lakhs be maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the managements / institutions.
  - Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government etc.
  - The institutions shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University / State Directorate of Education about the appointment of faculty members and the statement of Annual Accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
  - The institutions shall regularly update their website.
  - The institutions intending to run the teachers training programmes approved at rented premises are required to submit report in compliance of the requirements of NCTE Regulations on the subject regarding their shift to permanent building.

5. If any of the institutions contravene any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and / or order made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act 1993. The NCTE may also cause inspections under Section 13 of NCTE Act, 1993.

6. It is mandatory for the institutions to complete 180 teaching days as such the affiliating university/board should ensure the recognition granted as per NCTE regulations and if the recognition did not match with the academic calendar then the recognition granted shall be effective from the next academic session.


### WITHDRAWAL ORDER

**WHEREAS**, the recognition/permission was granted by the Western Regional Committee of National Council for Teacher Education ("NCTE") under Section 14/15 of NCTE Act, 1993 to (RAJIV GANDHI COLLEGE OF DIPLOMA IN EDUCATION, ASHTI - ALLAPALLI - ROAD, AT & POST - ASHTI, TAHASIL - CHAMORSHI, CITY:GADCHIROLI) for the following Teacher Education Programme:-

**2. AND WHEREAS**, Section 12(k) of the NCTE Act, 1993, empowers the NCTE to evolve suitable Performance Appraisal system, norms and mechanisms for enforcing accountability on recognised institutions. In light of this provision, the matter of Performance Appraisal Report ("PAR") was considered by the NCTE in its 61<sup>st</sup> General Body Meeting held on 05.08.2024. The NCTE considered and deliberated the issue and decided as below:

- The NCTE approved online Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) module which were to be filled by the recognised institutions.
- The NCTE approved replica of the online PAR module.
- The NCTE approved General Instructions for filling the PAR.
- The NCTE approved that the Public Notice for recognised institutions to submit the PAR for the academic session(s) 2021-22 & 2022-23.
- The NCTE approved, the format of certificate to be obtained from the affiliating body by the institution concerned that the institution is affiliated to it and is following all the norms and standards of NCTE for course recognised by the NCTE.
- The NCTE also authorized the Chairperson of NCTE to decide the timeline for submission of PAR by the recognised Teacher Education Institutions and for any further alteration and deletion on the online PAR module as per requirement for the aforesaid and subsequent academic session(s).

1. **AND WHEREAS**, in compliance of the above decision taken by the General Body of the Council (NCTE) vide Circular dated 08/09/2024 was issued by the NCTE with the direction to all recognized Teacher Education Institutions to submit FFR for the academic session 2024-25 by 15/11/2024 through online mode as per the link. The last date to submit the FFR was 15/11/2024 which was further extended to 16/11/2024 and subsequently to 11/12/2024 by the NCTE vide public notice dated 07/11/2024 & 16/11/2024, respectively.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, in addition to the above public notices, multiple attempts through print notices, regular reminders through e-mails and video messages of the Chairperson and Member Secretary of NCTE in this regard were uploaded across all major social media platforms with complete substantiation by Ministry of HR to spread awareness and sensitize all the recognized Teacher Education Institutions for timely submission of the FFR.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, in compliance of the decision of the General Body of the Council (NCTE) vide direction issued vide above referred public notices, the above institution has not submitted FFR for the academic session 2024-25. The matter was considered by the Western Regional Committee of NCTE in its meeting no. 44th and as per decision taken by the Regional Committee, show cause notice to provide reasonable opportunity to submit written representation before withdrawal of the above recognition/permission under section 17 of NCTE Act, 1999 on the ground of Non-submission of the FFR for the academic session 2024-25 was issued by NCTE to the institution through online mode on 16/04/2025, a copy of the same was also sent through speed post.


4. **AND WHEREAS**, all existing recognized Teacher Education Institutions were also informed vide Public Notice dated 02/04/2025 that show cause notice(s) under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1999 were being issued to the institutions that have not filled up the FFR by the Regional Committee(s) concerned, on the address(es) of the institution(s) available with the office of the Regional Committee(s) concerned with the direction to submit their reply within 15 days through online mode only from the date of issue of SCN on the NCTE web-portal ([https://par.ncte.gov.in/par\\_feedback\\_system/](https://par.ncte.gov.in/par_feedback_system/)).

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by the Western Regional Committee of NCTE in its meeting no. 424th held on 20/05/2025 and the committee decided that the recognition/permission granted to RAJIV GANDHI COLLEGE OF DIPLOMA IN EDUCATION as referred above be withdrawn under Section 17 of NCTE Act, 1999 on the following grounds/reasons with effect from the academic session 2025-2026. The institution is not entitled to admit students in the above referred programmes from the academic session 2025-2026. The students admitted up to the academic session 2024-2025 shall complete their programme.

i. The institution has not submitted any reply to the show cause notice.

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 17 of NCTE Act, 1999, the Western Regional Committee of NCTE hereby withdraws the recognition for the D.El.Ed( Marathi) Course granted to RAJIV GANDHI COLLEGE OF DIPLOMA IN EDUCATION as referred in the para-1 with effect from the academic session 2025-2026 on the ground/reasons given in the para-1 of this order. The institution is not entitled to admit students in the above referred programmes from the academic session 2025-2026. The students admitted up to the academic session 2024-2025 shall complete their programme.

7. If the institution is not satisfied with this order, it may prefer an appeal under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1999 through online mode available on NCTE website <https://ncte.gov.in/Appeal/Form/forjn.aspx> within 60 days from the date of issue of this order.







**I. GROUND OF WITHDRAWAL**

The appeal of **Rajiv Gandhi College of Diploma in Education, Survey No. 51 and 52, Allapalli Road, Chamorshi, Gadchiroli, Maharashtra - 442707** dated 03.10.2025 filed under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 is against the decision as per withdrawal order no. **F. No.NCTE/2025/WRC/PAR/ORDER/APW02611/122445/2791** dated 26.05.2025 of the Western Regional Committee, withdrawing recognition for conducting D.El.Ed. (Marathi) Course on the grounds that "The institution has not submitted any reply to the Show Cause Notice."

**II. SUBMISSIONS MADE BY APPELLANT: -**

The Representative of **Rajiv Gandhi College of Diploma in Education, Survey No. 51 and 52, Allapalli Road, Chamorshi, Gadchiroli, Maharashtra - 442707** appeared online to present the case of the appellant institution on 24.04.2026. In the appeal report, the appellant institution submitted that "Temporarily college admission process was stand still since 2016-17. Due to Non-availability of students for admission please consider our request."

**III. OUTCOME OF THE CASE: -**

The Appeal Committee, in its 6<sup>th</sup> Meeting, 2026 held online on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2026, considered the case of the appellant institution and carefully examined the Appeal Report, the impugned order passed by the concerned Regional Committee, the records available on file, the documents placed on record, and the submissions made by the appellant institution.

The Committee noted that the appellant institution was granted recognition for the D.El.Ed. (Marathi) course of two years' duration with an annual intake of 50 students vide order dated 12.04.2007. The recognition of the institution was withdrawn by the WRC vide order dated 26.05.2025 on the ground that the institution has not submitted any reply to the show cause notice. The case relates to the non-submission of PARs for the academic sessions 2021–2022 and 2022–2023. The last date for submission of PARs was initially fixed as 10.11.2024 and was subsequently extended up to 31.12.2024 through Public Notices.

The Appeal Committee considered the case in the present meeting and noted the submissions of the appellant institution, namely Rajiv Gandhi College of Diploma in Education, Ashti, Tah. Chamorshi, District Gadchiroli, Maharashtra, wherein it has submitted that the present appeal arises out of withdrawal of recognition on account of non-filing of the Performance Appraisal Report (PAR). The appellant institution submitted that the admission process of the college has remained non-operational since the academic session 2016-17 due to non-availability of students. It has requested that its case be considered in view of the said circumstances. The appellant further submitted, vide representation dated 06.04.2026 (received on 09.04.2026), an undertaking stating that no court case has been filed in respect of the appeal against the withdrawal order. It has also requested that an opportunity be granted to submit the pending PAR details through the online portal and to permit restarting of the institution.

The Appeal Committee observed that, in terms of Section 12(k) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the decision of the General Body in its 61st Meeting held on 05.08.2024, and subsequent Public Notices, submission of the Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) is a mandatory and time-bound compliance obligation for all recognized Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs). The requirement includes both submission of institutional information through the online portal and payment of the prescribed fee. The Committee also noted that adequate publicity and repeated opportunities were provided by the Council to ensure compliance by all TEIs. The Committee thereafter took note of the binding decision of the General Body of NCTE adopted in its 68th (Emergent) Meeting held on 25.11.2025, which is reproduced below verbatim:

### **“3. DECISION OF THE COUNCIL**

**3.1 In modification of the scope of the decision taken in the 67th General Body Meeting and to ensure procedural fairness, the General Body, after detailed deliberation, unanimously RESOLVED as follows:**

**(A) Approval of Final Opportunity:**

**The Council approves the reopening of the online PAR portal for a final, one-time opportunity for all TEIs to submit PAR for the Academic Sessions 2021-22 and 2022-23.**

**(B) Scope of Submission:**

**The opportunity is structured as follows:**

- **TEIs Recognized up to Academic Session 2021-22: Must submit PAR for both 2021-22 and 2022-23.**
- **TEIs Recognized in Academic Session 2022-23: Must submit PAR for 2022-23 only.**
- **TEIs Recognized in/after 2023-24: Are not required to submit PAR for this specific cycle.**

**(C) Stipulation of Consequence:**

**The Council reiterates that the submission of PAR is mandatory for the continuation of recognition. It is also categorically clarified that any TEI that fails to submit the PAR within this final stipulated window shall be liable for appropriate action being instituted against it in terms of Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 for withdrawal of its recognition.**

**(D) Mechanism for Withdrawn TEIs:**

**Access to the PAR portal shall remain restricted to TEIs whose recognition status is 'Active' or 'under judicial stay'.**

- **The Council notes that the status of 'Withdrawn' recognition, once finalized, creates a jurisdictional bar (functus officio) that prevents the Regional Committee from unilaterally reopening the matter.**
- **For TEIs whose recognition currently stands 'Withdrawn' on account of non-submission of PAR till 31.12.2024 and who have not approached any court; the onus is on the institution to demonstrate its operational intent. To avail of this final opportunity, such TEIs must first obtain an order of restoration or stay from a competent legal authority (i.e., the Hon'ble High Court or the NCTE Appellate Committee u/s 18) before the closing date of the portal window."**

The Appeal Committee observed that the appellant institution has failed to submit the Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) within the prescribed timeframe and continues to remain in non-compliance with the mandatory requirements stipulated under the provisions of the NCTE Act, 1993, the NCTE (Recognition Norms and

Procedure) Regulations, 2014 (as amended), and the directions issued by the Council from time to time. As per the submissions made by the appellant institution, it could not submit the PAR for the Academic Sessions 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 on account of the reasons stated in the appeal. The Committee further noted that the appellant institution has neither made any submission nor placed any material on record indicating that any court proceedings were filed or that the matter remained sub judice subsequent to withdrawal of recognition by the concerned Regional Committee. The Committee, while considering the binding decision of the General Body of the Council taken in its 68th (Emergent) Meeting held on 25.11.2025, specifically noted that the said decision squarely applies to the present case and, inter alia, provides that "For TEIs whose recognition currently stands 'Withdrawn' on account of non-submission of PAR till 31.12.2024 and who have not approached any court, the onus is on the institution to demonstrate its operational intent. To avail of this final opportunity, such TEIs must first obtain an order of restoration or stay from the competent legal authority (i.e. the Hon'ble High Court or the NCTE Appellate Committee)." The Committee further noted that, as per the aforesaid decision, the Council had directed the NCTE Appellate Committee to hear and dispose of appeals filed by such defaulting TEIs seeking restoration on a fast-track basis.

The Committee observed that submission of PAR within the stipulated period constitutes a mandatory statutory and regulatory obligation and that the burden to establish due compliance squarely rests upon the recognized institution through complete, contemporaneous, and duly authenticated documentary evidence. The Committee further observed that, in view of the aforesaid binding policy decision of the General Body dated 25.11.2025, the matter requires examination by the competent Regional Committee in accordance with the applicable statutory and regulatory framework. The Committee further noted that the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in *Rambha College of Education v. NCTE* [W.P.(C) No. 3231/2016] recognized that subsequent material and developments brought on record at the appellate stage may be considered by the Appellate Authority and that the matter may appropriately be remitted for reconsideration in accordance with law.

Appeal Committee further noted that the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order dated 08.04.2021, passed in W.P. (C) 4382/2021 has observed as follows: -

***"Appellate Committee of NCTE, is directed to ensure that, whenever an order of remand is passed, the status of the impugned is clearly spelt out so that the institution is not compelled to approach the Court in this manner."***

Appeal Committee noted that the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order dated 30.07.2021, passed in W.P. (C) 7260/2021 has observed as follows: -

***"Although the Appellate Committee of the NCTE would be well advised to expressly quash the original order of the concerned Regional Committee while remanding the matter, the position in law is that the order automatically stands quashed. The institution is, therefore, entitled to the benefits of recognition until a fresh withdrawal order is passed."***

Noting the Appeal Report, the submissions placed on record, the material available in the appeal file, the binding decisions of the General Body, and the applicable statutory and regulatory framework, and upon careful, independent, and objective consideration of the entire matter, the Appeal Committee is of the considered view that the impugned order dated 26.5.2025 deserves to be set aside and the matter remanded to the Western Regional Committee for fresh consideration in accordance with law. The appellant institution is directed to forward to the Regional Committee concerned immediately upon receipt of this order, all documents submitted along with the present appeal, including any additional material sought to be relied upon by it. Such remand is considered necessary to facilitate due examination of the records and documents placed on record and to ensure that the matter is examined strictly in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Act, 1993, the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2014 (as amended), applicable guidelines, and the binding decisions/resolutions of the General Body. The Western Regional Committee, being the competent statutory authority and custodian of institutional records, shall undertake a comprehensive, independent, and reasoned examination of the matter strictly in accordance with law and the applicable regulatory framework. It is clarified that the present remand shall not be construed either as an expression of

opinion on the merits of the case or as conferring any equity or vested right upon the appellant institution. It is further clarified that the appellant institution shall be required to establish strict, complete, and demonstrable compliance with all prescribed statutory and regulatory requirements through duly authenticated and verifiable documentary evidence, and the matter shall thereafter be dealt with by the competent authority in accordance with law.

#### IV. DECISION:

After careful consideration of the Appeal Report, the impugned order, the material available on record, the submissions of the appellant institution, and the binding decisions of the General Body dated 25.11.2025, the Appeal Committee, in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, hereby sets aside the impugned order dated 26.05.2025 and remands the matter to the Western Regional Committee for fresh consideration in accordance with law. The appellant institution shall immediately forward all documents submitted along with the appeal to the Regional Committee concerned. The Western Regional Committee shall examine the matter afresh in terms of the NCTE Act, 1993, the NCTE Regulations, 2014 (as amended), and the binding decisions of the General Body, and thereafter pass a reasoned and speaking order within a time-bound manner. The appeal stands disposed of accordingly.

The original file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were considered by WRC and the Committee observed as under:-

**Facts of the case**

1. This institution was recognised by WRC with an annual intake of 100 students vide order dated 31.08.2006.
2. After promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the Revised recognition order was issued to the institution vide order No. WRC/APW01998/123283/2015 /142595,601, 603,608, 621,625,631 dated 31.5.2015 with an annual intake of 100 students.
3. The request of the institution for reduction of intake of the institution to one unit was considered by WRC and as per the decision of 259th meeting of WRC held on September 21-23, 2016 an order reducing the intake from 100 to 50 was issued vide Order No. WRC/APW01998/123283/259th/ 2016/ 182636-41 dated 28.3.2017.
4. The institution requested for reopening of 2<sup>nd</sup> unit of B.Ed. with an intake of 50 students on 2.4.2022 & on 24.11.2023.
5. The institution approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and the Hon'ble Court in W.P. (C) 4151/2026 has passed order dated: 01.04.2026 directing the respondents i.e NCTE to decide the petitioners' representation dated 23.11.2023, expeditiously by a speaking order within 8 weeks from today.

**Decision of WRC:**

In pursuance of order dated 01.04.2026 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, the Committee noted that as per available record of WRC, there is no representation dated 23.11.2023 rather as per available record of WRC, NCTE, there is representation dated 24.11.2023. The representation dated 24.11.2023 was considered by WRC and WRC observed the following :-

- i. On the request received from the institution, the intake of B.Ed. course has been reduced by WRC from 100 to 50 vide order dated 28.03.2017.
- ii. The Committee noted that the institution in its representation has sought re-opening of 2<sup>nd</sup> unit of B.Ed. course, which would amount to an increase in annual intake from the existing 50 (one unit) to 100 (two units).
- iii. As per Section 15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, read with the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2014, and the National Council for Teacher Education Rules, 1997, an institution seeking an increase of intake in an existing recognised course is mandatorily required to submit a fresh application in online mode in the prescribed format, along with the prescribed processing fee.
- iv. No such application has been submitted by the institution through the prescribed online mode as required under the extant Regulations. In view of the above, the representation of the institution seeking restoration of the second unit in the B.Ed. course cannot be acceded to, as allowing the same in the absence of a formal application would be contrary to and in contravention of the relevant provisions of the NCTE Act, 1993, Rules and Regulations made thereunder, and would lead to an

The institution filled an Appeal under section 18 of the NCTE Act and the Appeal Committee vide order dated 11.05.2026 decided as under:-</p> <p><i>“After careful consideration of the Appeal Report, the impugned order, the material available on record, the submissions of the appellant institution, and the binding decisions of the General Body dated 25.11.2025, the Appeal Committee, in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, hereby sets aside the impugned order dated 26.05.2025 and remands the matter to the Western Regional Committee for fresh consideration in accordance with law. The appellant institution shall immediately forward all documents submitted along with the appeal to the Regional Committee concerned. The Western Regional Committee shall examine the matter afresh in terms of the NCTE Act, 1993, the NCTE Regulations, 2014 (as amended), and the binding decisions of the General Body, and thereafter pass a reasoned and speaking order within a time-bound manner. The appeal stands disposed of accordingly.”</i></p> <p><b>The WRC decided that as per the decision of Appellate Authority, Restoration order for D.El.Ed course with an annual intake of 50 students (One Unit) be issued to the institution.</b></p>
